Austria is constitutionally non-aligned, but is an EU member and actively participates in EU peacekeeping and crisis management operations under the Common Security and Defense Policy; Austria is not a member of NATO, but joined NATO's Partnership for Peace framework in 1995 and participates in NATO-led crisis management and peacekeeping ...
