Does Sembcorp have a Bess project?

The Singapore Electricity Market Authority (EMA) has confirmed that the Southeast Asia region's largest battery storage project to date is on course for commissioning in November.

What is a Bess project?

The goal was established as part of the Accelerating Energy Storage Access for Singapore (ACCESS) EMA initiative, which was used to hold the EOI request. It is the country's second grid-scale BESS project, the first being a Wartsila project with 2.4 MWh that was delivered and turned on in 2020.

Should Bess projects be proposed in Singapore?

One industry source told recently that proposing BESS projects for development in Singapore is challenging given the lack of space in urban areas of the densely populated territory, and commensurate regulations on fire safety and urban planning, among other things.

Where is Bess located in Singapore?

The BESS is located on 2 hectares of land on Jurong Island, which is heavily industrialised and features much of Singapore's energy generation and infrastructure.

How will Singapore's Bess project help reduce solar intermittency?

As a result of the project, Singapore has reached its BESS goal of over 200 MWh of energy storage capacity three years ahead of schedule. Singapore's new BESS will help mitigate the solar intermittency caused by changing weather conditions in the region's tropical climate.

What is Bess & how does it work in ASEAN?

Typical BESS components include battery modules, a storage enclosure with thermal management, a power conversion system (PCS), a battery management system (BMS) and an energy management system (EMS). A few other ASEAN countries are also starting to wake up to the advantages of BESS in their respective energy sectors. But, it's a slow start.

Construction of the 285MWh giant container-like battery system was built in just six months, becoming the fastest BESS of its size in the world to be completed. As a result of the project, Singapore has reached its BESS goal of over 200 MWh of energy storage capacity three years ahead of schedule.

Officially inaugurated in early 2023 on the island which houses much of Singapore's industrial and energy infrastructure, the BESS project is the biggest of its kind in Southeast Asia. It was developed by Sembcorp in collaboration with the Singapore Energy Market Authority (EMA) after winning an EMA contract through a solicitation.
