Will solar panels boost Cuba's electric power?

The Cuban government plans to invest significantly in photovoltaic parks and wind farms to address the severe energy crisis that has plagued the island for several months. The Havana authorities also intend to assist citizens with installing solar panels.

Will Cuba's energy investment strengthen the national energy system?

This investment is expected to significantly strengthen the national energy system. Since October, Cuba has experienced total paralysis of the national energy system three times, caused by a malfunction at the main Antonio Guiteras power plant in Matanzas in the western part of the country.
