It is nailed to a stud on one side, find what side the stud is on and cut the nails with a recip saw. Replace the box with an "old work" box, the ones with folding ears.

So working the existing junction box, which seems to be made up of particle board, I was able to remove two screws that were bracketed (see the blue arrows) that I thought were ...
