Is Malawi a good place to invest in solar energy?

"Salima Solar is the first solar PV plant in Malawi to be connected to the national grid. As such, it is a model for future projects in several ways... In particular, it demonstrates that Malawi is an attractive destination for private sector investment in energy," says President Lazarus McCarthy Chakwera at the plant's inauguration ceremony.

Where is Malawi's first solar power plant located?

The centrally located facility is Malawi's first solar power plant connected to the national grid, a project successfully completed under a public-private partnership (PPP). The President of the Republic of Malawi Lazarus McCarthy Chakwera visited the Salima district, 101 km from the capital Lilongwe, on November 16, 2021.

What are some solar energy developments in Malawi?

In Malawi, solar energy developments are helping local communities maintain sustainable energy. For instance, Bwengu Projects Malawi provides teachers in high-needs schools with solar-powered LED projectors in Bwengu, the northern countryside of Malawi.

How many GWh will the Salima solar power plant produce?

The Salima solar plant will be capable of producing 154 GWh per year. The Salima solar power plant is the result of a public-private partnership (PPP) project originally developed by JCM Power Corporation, Matswani, and InfraCo Africa, a Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG) company.

Why is TA funding Salima solar?

TA has also provided a further \$6 million Viability Gap Funding grant to the project to accelerate progress to construction. As the country's first commercial-scale solar IPP, Salima Solar has considerable potential for replication; promoting further development of Malawi's solar resource.

What is the Bwengu Solar Park Project?

The Bwengu Solar Park Project is a local initiative to bring more energy to the community in Malawi through the creation of solar farms. The development, which began in August 2019, should generate approximately 50 megawatts of renewable energy per year to feed into homes and local businesses.

The 20 megawatt (MW) Golomoti Solar Project in Malawi is the first of its scale in Southern Africa to include a battery energy storage system, which will enable the plant to provide reliable,...

The state-of-the-art power plant is the first utility-scale grid-connected hybrid solar and battery energy storage project in Malawi and the largest in Sub-Saharan Africa. It comprises 52,000 bi-facial solar panels and ...
