

How many international grid lines are there in Italy?

Italian international grid connections comprise several lines connecting the national grid with Europe: 4 with France, 12 with Switzerland, 1 with Austria, 2 with Slovenia, 1 with Greece, 1 with Corsica. In addition, a new subsea HCDC power line was installed in 2015 between Sicily and Malta.

How does the Italian electricity system work?

The Italian electricity system's balance: the energy required on the national grid to meet net internal consumption ("total load") is equal to the sum of net electricity produced and electricity imported from abroad, from which energy absorbed by pumping and energy exported are subtracted.

Who provides high voltage electricity in Italy?

The transmission of high voltage electricity in Italy is provided by Terna. The transmission network has 63,500 km of HV lines, 22 interconnection lines with foreign countries, 445 transformer stations.

Does Italy have a single digital platform?

For the first time, the Italian national transmission grid operator is publishing its operating data, market data and statistics on the electricity system on a single integrated digital platform.

How does Terna connect electricity plants to the national transmission grid?

Connecting an electricity plant to the national transmission grid is managed by Terna, which is obliged to connect all entities to the grid that make the request and, in particular, is responsible for the high- and extra-high voltage connection of plants with a capacity of 10 MW or more.
