Turks and Caicos Islands uses power plugs and sockets of type A and B, with a standard voltage of 120 V and a frequency of 60 Hz. If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter.

The electricity standard in the Turks and Caicos is 120v, 60Hz and U.S. style power plugs. Solar-derived power is increasing in popularity, with many private installations visible throughout the country, especially on new Turks and Caicos villa projects.

Electricity in Turks and Caicos Islands - voltage and frequency. All power sockets in Turks and Caicos Islands provide a standard voltage of 120V with a standard frequency of 60Hz. You can use all your equipment in Turks and Caicos Islands if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 100V-127V.

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The standard on the islands within Turks and Caicos is 120 volts/60 cycles equivalent to the US Standard. If traveling from North America you should be able to use your appliances without any problems, however if traveling from Europe you will need adapters and transformers.
