

The Republic of Nauru is an island of just 21 square kilometres, with more than 9,500 citizens, that is highly dependent on imported fossil fuels for transport and power generation. The 500kW solar PV plant bolsters energy resilience by contributing electricity to the national grid.

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A 1.15MWp PV generation system is installed at the old "Canstruct" site on the south end of Nauru and connected to the NUC 11kV local distribution network. The system, designed and installed by Clay Energy as an EPC project, is referred to as the NZ MFAT PV system and is accomplished to meet the increasing electricity generation needs for ...

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The Solar Power Development Project will finance (i) a grid-connected solar power plant with a capacity of 6 megawatts (MW) of alternating current; and (ii) a 2.5-megawatt-hour, 5 MW battery energy storage system (BESS) to enable smoothing of intermittent solar

Together, GHD teams New Zealand, the Philippines, Australia, and the UK, with support from local team members in Nauru, have prepared a Solar Expansion Plan and Feasibility Study for a grid-connected solar power plant and a battery energy storage system.

In the southwestern part of the island nation, rows of blue photovoltaic panels are neatly arranged close to the azure sea, reflecting the dazzling tropical sunlight. Once connected to the grid, the photovoltaic power generation and energy storage project being constructed by a Chinese company can meet the electricity demand of the entire island.

1. The project will finance a 6MW grid connected solar power plant (measured as AC output) and 2.5MWh/5MW battery energy storage system (BESS) for solar smoothing energy storage (SSES). The system will be fully integrated and automated with the existing diesel generation

The project will directly support the target of 50% renewable energy for Nauru under the Nauru Energy Road Map 2018-2020, and assist the country in achieving its nationally determined contributions under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

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
