The Falkland current and frontal zones The Falkland Islands are surrounded by the Falkland Current (Fig. 1) which itself is derived from the northernmost branch of the Antarctic Circumpolar Current coming through the Drake Passage (Palma et al., 2021; Peterson and Whitworth, 1989).

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The Falkland Islands are an archipelago of 778 islands with an area of 12,173 km² (4,700 sq mi) located in the South Atlantic Ocean on a projection of the Patagonian Shelf. The two principal islands, East Falkland and West Falkland, account for 91% of the land area.
