

The renewables unit of China National Nuclear Power (CNNP) is considering a move into the solar market of the Southeast Asian market of Timor-Leste, two sources told Infralogic. CNNP Rich Energy is interested in taking part in an international tender to develop a solar plus battery energy storage system, they said.

From Timor-Leste, Ms. Arlinda Maria R.F.F. Miranda, General Director of the General Directorate for the Regulation of the Electricity, Water, and Sanitation Sectors emphasized, "Timor-Leste requires increased investment in renewable energy projects, along with capacity-building and a regulatory framework that supports such initiatives.

For instance, in Indonesia industrial electricity tariffs are 0.11 USD/kWh, compared to 0.24 USD/kWh in Timor-Leste.
